STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Allow the engine and exhaust system to cool.

STEP 2 Test fit the helmet lock on the motorcycle to ensure that the helmet will not damage or interfere with any other components on your motorcycle.

Do not install the tamper-proof screws at this time.

NOTE: It is very important to perform the "test-fit" due to the extreme difficulty in removing the tamper-proof screws after they are tightened.

STEP 3 Insert the tamper-proof screws through the front side of the helmet lock as shown in PIC.1.

STEP 4 Tighten the screws evenly and ensure that the helmet lock is properly clamped onto the tube.
