#### FEATURES OF THE CRUSIN' DELUXE TOOL POUCH:

- Leading-edge style and construction matches a variety of motorcycles from customs to performance cruisers.
- Rugged 3mm SaddleHyde material and cylindrical shape works great holding tool rolls or just about any kind of cargo.
- Contents stay clean and dry opening covered by weather flaps fitted with a ¼ turn hasp that accepts a mini padlock for security.
- Comes with two strong, nylon straps with d-rings, plus hook and loop combo straps for easy mounting in a variety of positions.
- Works great as a windshield bag when paired up with Saddlemen's chrome windshield bracket.

### ⚠ WARNING

#### READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE INSTALLATION!

Because of the variety of motorcycle configurations, other accessories, and the features and intended use of this Saddlemen accessory, there are many different mounting options. You are responsible for the proper installation of this accessory on your motorcycle. Your attention to these installation instructions and recommendations will permit safe and proper use of this accessory. You must mount this accessory properly and securely before riding your motorcycle. If you lack the ability to safely and properly install this accessory, seek out a qualified motorcycle technician for assistance. During installation, support the motorcycle with a suitable stand or lift so it will not tip over and injure you, or damage the vehicle. Using or mounting this accessory improperly could result in a loss of control of the motorcycle which could result in damage to your motorcycle or other personal property, the property of third parties, and/or personal injury to yourself or others, up to and including death.

#### BE SURE TO THOROUGHLY READ AND CLOSELY FOLLOW THE MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS THAT ARE INCLUDED WITH THIS ACCESSORY:

- Be sure to thoroughly read and closely follow the Mounting Instructions that are included with this accessory tool pouch.
- This tool pouch must be installed and securely fastened onto the handlebars, rear luggage rack or front fork assembly.
- For your safety, mount the tool pouch securely so it will not shift or move while riding. Make sure the accessory will not contact the controls, the wheels, or any other moving parts of your vehicle.
- Thoroughly inspect your tool pouch before every ride. Do not use your accessory if the mounting system has been modified, or has deteriorated, loosened or is beginning to fail.
- Do not exceed four pounds of total cargo weight, including the weight of the tool pouch itself, in your pouch.
- When using this or any accessory, do not exceed your saddlebag's Maximum Cargo Load Capacity, or your vehicle's Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight as listed on your vehicle or in the manufacturer's owner's manual.
- Carefully secure and protect items placed in the tool pouch (use special care to protect eye wear or electronics).
- Do not transport or store flammable or potentially explosive materials in your tool pouch.
- Continually check the security of the pouch at each stop as you ride. Hardware and straps on a motor vehicle can loosen during operation, so be sure to check these items frequently.
- If your tool pouch is ever damaged, do not use it until it has been inspected by a professional motorcycle dealer. Replace the pouch immediately if it has damage that will prevent it from being properly secured to your vehicle or if it is unable to securely hold it's contents.
- If you do not understand the Mounting Instructions or this warning label DO NOT mount this Tool Pouch and remove any other items you may have installed on your vehicle. Contact your local professional motorcycle dealer for assistance, or call the Saddlemen support line at (310) 638-1222.

#### DO NOT ATTEMPT TO USE THIS ACCESSORY IF:

- You do not understand these installation and use instructions,
- You do not understand any part of the accessory mounting system,
- You have any doubts as to the security of the mounting system.

If you have any concerns or questions, seek help at your qualified motorcycle dealer or call the Saddlemen support line at (310) 638-1222.

Remember: Motorcycling can be a dangerous activity. Installation of any accessory can increase your risk if it is not installed properly. You are responsible to install this accessory so it will not contact any portion of the drive train, suspension or steering, or if it will in any way interfere with the operation of your motorcycle.

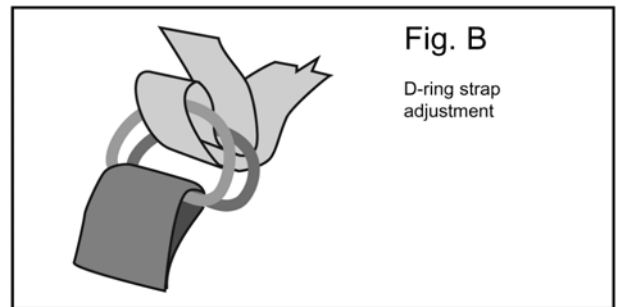
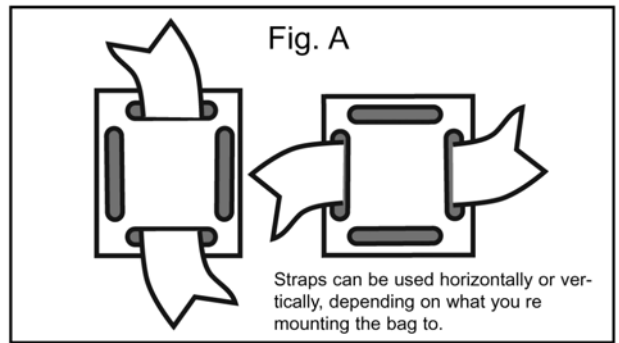

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Your Crusin' Deluxe Tool Pouch has been designed to universally fit on a variety of motorcycles. By using the two included mounting straps, the pouch can be attached to many different locations on your motorcycle such as the front fork triple clamp, the sissybar, the handlebars or luggage rack.
2. Two durable nylon mounting straps with double D-rings are included. Some applications will require the use of both straps; for some applications one long strap will work best.
3. Insert the strap(s) into each square strap anchor located on the back of the pouch. See Fig. A: Straps can be inserted vertically (for triple clamp or handlebar installation) or horizontally (for fork tube or sissybar installation).
4. Straps can be cut to eliminate excess length. Use a scissors to trim the end of the strap to the desired length and then use a controllable heat source (such as a soldering iron) to cauterize the end of the nylon strap.
5. Once you have determined the best pouch location and strap length, you will need to cinch the loose strap end into the end with the double D-ring. Fig. B: Cinch the strap by routing the end through both D-rings, then loop the end between the two rings and finally back through the inner D-ring. Make sure to tighten both straps securely so the pouch will not slide, or move around or come into contact with a tire or any other moving part of the motorcycle while riding.



## IMPORTANT:

Failure to install this accessory properly may allow portions of the tool pouch or its mounting straps to contact the vehicle's control or to interfere with your cargo. It is vital that you verify that the accessory and/or any of its parts will not touch, or interfere with your operation of the motorcycle. Do not connect the straps to any flexible or moving parts (rubber mounted turn signals, swing arm or shock). You must tuck away, trim or tie-off all loose mounting strap material BEFORE you ride your motorcycle. It is your responsibility to make sure the installation does not create an unsafe or illegal situation.

After 50 miles (80 kilometers), recheck the mounting of your tool pouch to make sure it is still securely attached to the motorcycle. Inspect the pouch's mounting before and during each ride. A loose accessory can interfere with the vehicle's operation and cause an unsafe riding condition.



## CARE OF YOUR SADDLEMEN ACCESSORY:

Your Tool Pouch requires almost no maintenance, other than periodic cleaning. Use Saddlemen Seat & Saddlebag Ultra Wash (#3101) for the best results while cleaning, or use mild soap and water. Protect the finish and enhance the appearance of your accessory with Saddlemen's Seat & Saddlebag Fabric Conditioner (#3103).
